This guide describes steps how to activate PDF Share Forms Enterprise Designer features on publishing type Share Point site collection.

Additional steps are necessary because PDF Share Forms Designer feature use “SiteAssets” document library for functioning but publishing-type sites do not create “SiteAssets” document library automatically as other site types do it. For that reason, this library should be created manually.

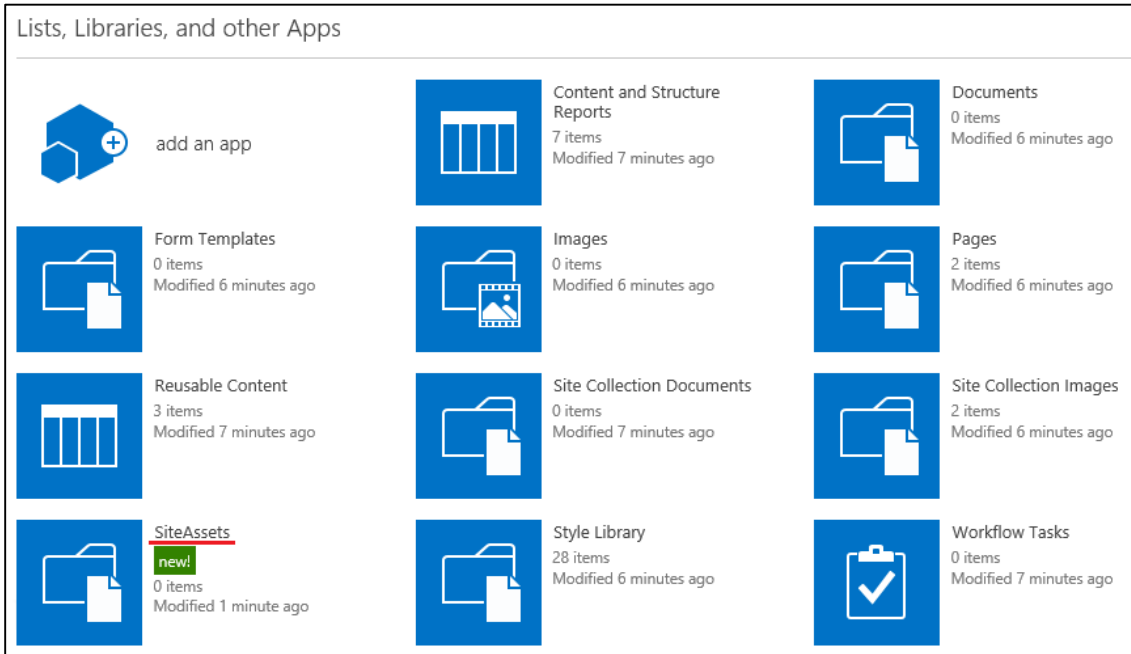
NOTE: Publishing site collections are ones which are created from “Publishing” templates

Step 1. Open publishing site and activate PDF Share Forms Runtime feature. Navigate to **Site Settings** → **Site collection features**

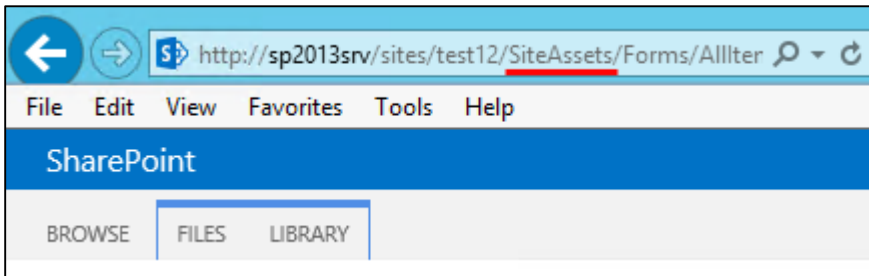
	Open Documents in Client Applications by Default Configures links to documents so they open in client applications instead of Web applications, by default.	Activate
	PDF Share Forms Runtime	Deactivate Active
	PerformancePoint Services Site Collection Features Features enabling the PerformancePoint Services site including content types and site definitions for this site collection.	Activate

Step 2. Navigate to **Site Content** → **Add an app** and create Document Library with name “SiteAssets”

NOTE: Name should be without spaces



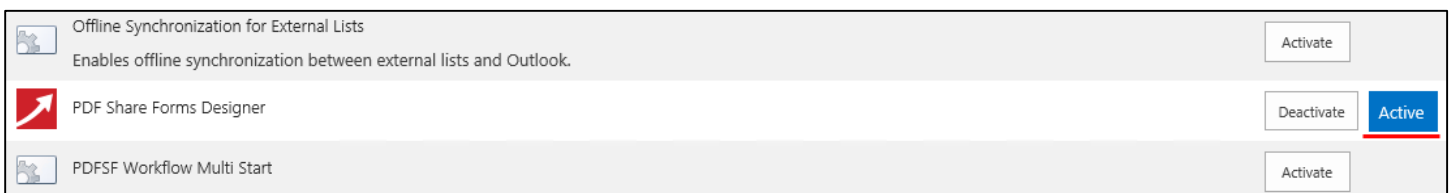
NOTE2: check that library name actually is “SiteAssets” – may be situation that library with this name already exist. To check a name navigate to this library and check URL:



If previously created library name would already be used then in URL of this new library would be “SiteAssets1”.

If such situation appears, then both this libraries should be deleted through Share Point designers and new “SiteAssets” library should be created.

Step 3. Navigate to **Site Setting** → **Manage site features** and activate PDF Share Forms Designer feature



Now all PDF Share Forms features are activated and product can be used.
